# A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Doing a show in the middle of a pandemic was not an easy task. Especially a show that took place at school, in a time when so many were remote learning. When times were so uncertain and changing day by day, and yet here we are. I look at this show and this process and the world and circumstances it was built around and can't help but be so proud of every single one of these kids. This is no easy show under normal conditions, it's musically very challenging and the dance and cheer is far from what most would expect from a typical musical but every single one of these kids, not only stepped it up and brought their "A" game to every rehearsal but also lifted each other up, supported each other, and made this show what you see tonight.

As I think about talking about what high school was like in the 2000's, I don't think I recognized how much it had truly changed. I think of the show *21 Jump Street*... Would I be able to fit in under cover at a high school right now? I think they'd know pretty fast. The strides that have been made socially are staggering, and it's truly refreshing to see that these toxic norms have faded out with my generation. Sure, not all things have changed for the best, but having to explain the music, and the culture, and the sayings people used in the 2000s, seemed to these kids like I was talking about ancient times.

I see this show as a time capsule of an era that wasn't all that long ago, but truly had a very iconic feel and look to it. A show that perfectly embraces that winning in life is better than winning any competition and that no matter how behind you feel compared to who you're up against... high school is only the beginning, and you can always go on to bigger and better things.

This show deals with the fast personal growth that takes place in the teenage years, and while working on this show I have seen that happen right before my eyes. These kids have grown to be responsible, and extremely compassionate young adults in a matter of months, and normally I would say that is just a part of growing up, but each one of them has so much to be proud of. I know they are dreading this show ending I hope they all remember their will be another show. I know this production got us all through a very difficult time in the world, but like all shows, the final curtain will close, and I hope this cast keeps growing and flourishing into the amazing performers you already are becoming.

Thank you to all Cast, Crew, Kids Coop, and Families for helping make this show possible, and bringing the lights back to the stage after waiting in the wings for so long.
